Scope of work:

The successful candidate will have excellent written and spoken Arabic (dialect & formal), proven proficiency in written English, an interest in Syria and strong analytical skills.



Terms of Reference:

A. Research and Media Monitoring in Arabic (40%)

- Conducting media monitoring of open source Arabic news sites, social media pages and reports related to the Syrian conflict
- Summarising media coverage of developments to the conflict, triangulating field findings with online media and mapping reported incidents geographically.

B. Assisting with report writing and graphics deliverables (30%)

- Supporting Integrity project teams with report drafting and delivery in English, either through note making and/or drafting specific report sections
- Supporting Integrity project teams with map-making and design.

C. Administrative tasks and data management (30%)

- Ensuring that Integrity project teams' data is organised and coded so as to be easily accessible
- Uploading Arabic questionnaires and data collection tools into Electronic Data Collection (EDC) platforms and testing their application.

 A Bachelor's degree in Modern Languages, Oriental Studies, History, Politics, Anthropology, Geography or similar (Minimum of 2:1 or equivalent).
