Project Background

The MELS activity serves as the Mission's primary mechanism for monitoring, evaluation, and learning and adaptive management services for ongoing activities and programs. In a dynamic operating environment, MELS provides USAID/South Sudan with flexible, demand-driven technical, analytic, and advisory support in order to strengthen collaboration, learning and adapting (CLA); promote institutional memory; produce monitoring, evaluation, learning products as appropriate; strengthen knowledge management and organizational learning (KMOL), organizational effectiveness and operational efficiency; and strengthen data-driven decision-making through an efficient use of GIS and other innovative spatial analysis.



Scope of Work

Conduct a gender and inclusion audit of USAID/South Sudan's programming, focusing on adherence to policy and the capacity of USAID/South Sudan implementing partners to integrate gender into their activities.

The audit is intended to consider mechanisms established by implementing partners to integrate gender throughout USAID-funded activities, share experiences, best practices and innovative approaches that promote gender-inclusive interventions during activity implementation, monitoring, and evaluation. It will also focus on advancing gender-related issues that align with USAID/South Sudan's development objectives and intermediate results.

This is a Short-Term Technical Assistance (STTA) position with a period of performance of early August to end of September. Travel to Juba, South Sudan may be required.

Terms of Reference

- Conduct a gender and inclusion audit consisting of a document review and primary data collection through a survey.
- Lead key informant interviews for USAID/South Sudan and implementing partners.
- Produce a gender assessment report to understand the existing capacities and gaps.
- Provide recommendations for gender integration by implementing partners.
- Consult with other Integrity Global and/or MSI staff as needed.

Your Experience and Expertise

- Bachelor's degree in a social science or other relevant fields is required.
- Minimum of five years of technical experience conducting USAID gender and inclusion analyses, assessments, and/or gender audits is required.
- Familiarity with South Sudan's gender dynamics and issues related to inclusion.
- Experience with rapid data collection and analysis including developing data collection guides, literature reviews, and questionnaires required.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Must be able to maintain stable internet, use video conferencing software.
- Must be available for travel to and within South Sudan, if required. Travel will only be approved based on security considerations, including COVID-19 contexts.

Languages:

- · Written and oral fluency in English, with the ability to write clear and compelling narrative.
- Oral and written fluency in one or more South Sudanese languages is preferred.
