- 8,244,775** Family planning users

*DALYs = Disability-Adjusted Life Year

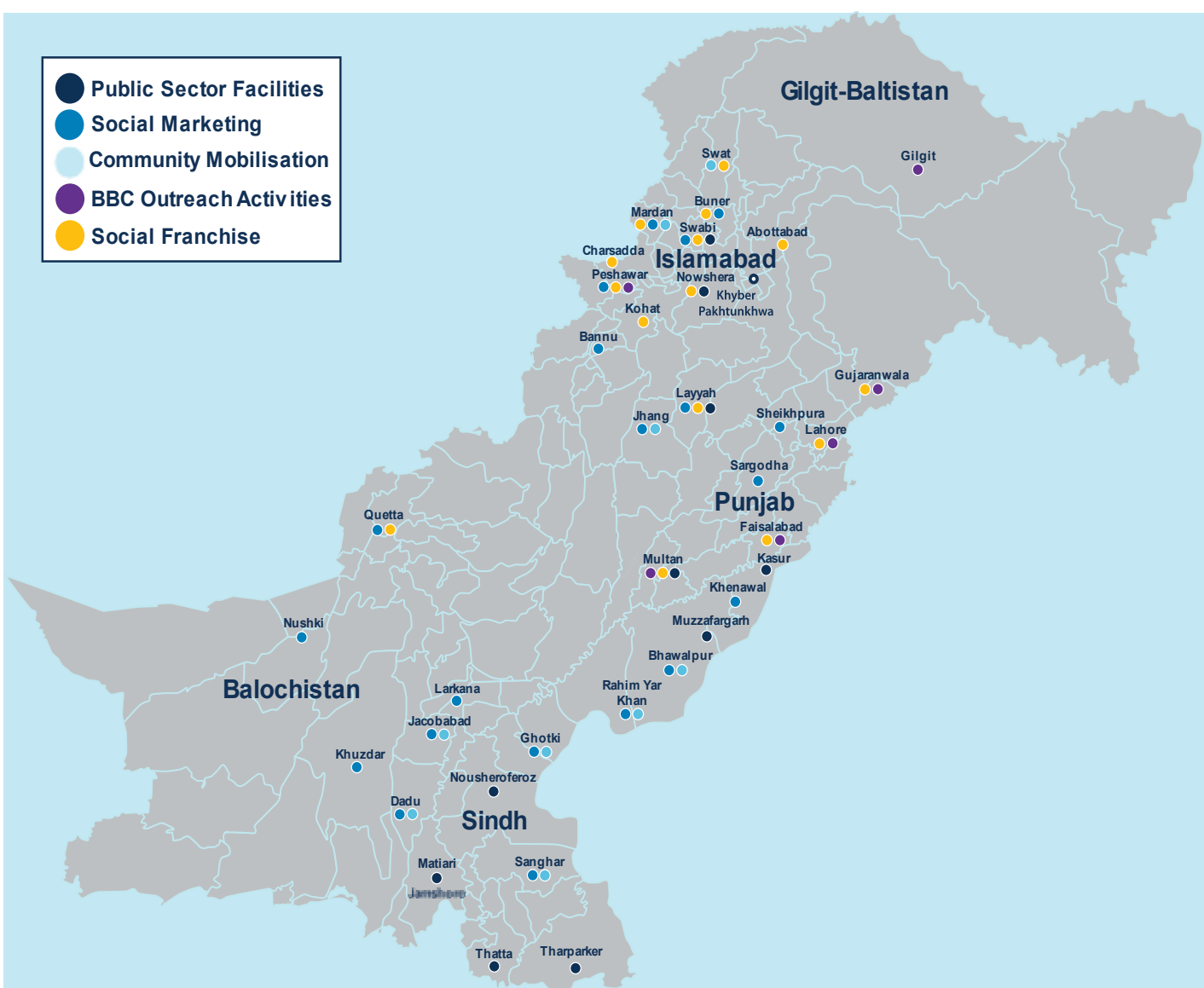

- Quarterly and annual reviews of performance data including value for money analysis** → Integrity standardised DAFPAK implementing partners' reporting across a number of disaggregates - equity, disability, age, geography, and care quality standards, allowing for in-depth insights and analysis.
- Third party monitoring and validation of partners reported results and activities** → Field validations gathered beneficiary feedback and conducted independent assessments resulting in more availability of supplies and services, improved provider-client interaction and greater client satisfaction.
- Annual household surveys to assess the impact of DAFPAK on family planning (FP) in Pakistan** → Annual Household Survey provided empirical evidence on the impact of DAFPAK programme on family planning outcomes compared to non DAFPAK areas. Findings led to actionable recommendations at both policy and implementation levels.
- Primary and secondary research to identify gaps and provide recommendations at policy and implementation levels for improving access and quality to FP services** → Rapid review and research study to assess the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic and floods response on supply and demand of family planning services resulted in generation of critical evidence for improving service delivery.
- Data visualisation to support evidence uptake and engagement** → Integrity's data visualisations provides insightful analysis so the FCDO and other stakeholders can easily engage with findings and take appropriate actions.
